RE: Docket No.010820-TP|Petition by Verizon Florida Inc. (f/k/a GTE Florida Incorporated) for approval of first amendment to existing interconnection agreement with Sprint Spectrum L.P.

By letter dated June 6, 2001, Verizon Florida, Inc. filed a Request for approval of first amendment to interconnection agreement entered into between Verizon Florida, Inc. and Sprint Spectrum L.P.. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was September 4, 2001.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on June 16, 2001. The agreement met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.17 of the Administrative Procedures Manual. Therefore, it has gone into effect by operation of law in accordance with Section 252(e)(4) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
