Issue 1: What is the appropriate method of projecting customers and consumption for the projected test year ending December 31, 2001, and what are the resulting projected numbers of customers and consumption for the 2001 projected test year before any adjustments are made?

- Issue 2: What conservation programs are appropriate for this utility?
- Issue 3: What is the appropriate level of conservation expenses?
- Issue 4: What is the appropriate resulting reduction in total consumption?
- Issue 5: What is the appropriate projected number of purchased water gallons from Pasco County, and what is the resulting expense?
- Issue 6: What is the appropriate rate structure for this utility?
- Issue 7: Is repression of consumption likely to occur, and, if so, what is the appropriate adjustment and the resulting consumption to be used to calculate consumption charges?
- Issue 8: What are the appropriate monthly rates for service?




