ORDER FIXING DEADLINE TO FILE APPLICATIONS FOR PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIMS AND APPROVING THE FORM AND MANNER OF NOTICE THEREOF

Upon consideration of the Motion (the "Motion") for Order Fixing the Deadline to File Applications for Payment of Administrative Claims and Approving the Form and Manner of Notice Thereof filed by the above-captioned debtor and debtor-in-possession (the "Debtor"); the Court having reviewed the Motion; and it appearing that proper and adequate notice of the Motion has been given and that no other or further notice is necessary, and it appearing that the establishment of deadlines for filing applications for payment of administrative claims is in the best interest of the Debtor, its estate, its creditors and other parties-in-interest, and it appearing to the Court that notice of the bar date given as required by this Order is reasonably calculated, under all circumstances present herein, to apprise the creditors and other parties-in-interest of the bar date, and to provide them with sufficient opportunity to file applications against the Debtor; and upon the record herein and after due deliberation thereon and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby

ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Any person or entity who requests payment of an administrative expense of the kind specified in Section 503(b) of the Bankruptcy Code and entitled to priority pursuant to Section 507(a)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code (but not including professionals retained by the Debtor or the Committee pursuant to order of this Court) from the Debtor, and who asserts an Administrative Claim, whether such Administrative Claim is matured or unmatured, disputed or undisputed, liquidated or unliquidated, fixed or contingent, legal or equitable, against the Debtor, which Administrative Claim arose from and between April 24, 2001 and September 30, 2001 (each, an "Administrative Claim") shall on or before October 31, 2001 (the "Administrative Claim Bar Date") file an application asserting such Administrative Claim with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, 219 South Dearborn Street, Room 710, Chicago, IL 60604 (the "Clerk") and serve a copy of such application on the following:

2. On or before September 27, 2001, Poorman-Douglas Corporation shall serve by first class United States mail a copy of this Order on: (a) each individual or entity that has filed with this Court, as of the date the order granting this Motion is entered, a notice of appearance or request for notice in this case; (b) those individuals or entities designated in Rule 2002(j) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; and (c) all individuals or entities listed on the Debtor's schedules as holding claims against the Debtor and non-debtor parties to leases or contracts with the Debtor.

3. The Debtor is authorized to publish the Notice of Deadline to File Applications for Payment of Administrative Claims (a copy of which is attached to this Order as Exhibit A) in the national edition of the *Wall Street Journal* on one occasion on or before October 1, 2001.

4. The service of this Order and the publication of the notice is reasonably calculated to provide unknown claimants, and parties-in-interest whose last known address is no longer correct, with sufficient time to assert a claim or otherwise protect their rights.

5. Any person or entity that is required to file an application for an Administrative Claim but does not do so on or before the Administrative Claim Bar Date shall, with respect to any such Administrative Claim, be forever barred from: (a) filing a proof of claim or application with respect to such Administrative Claim; (b) asserting such Administrative Claim against the Debtor or its estate or property; (c) voting on any plan or plans filed in this case; and (d) participating in or receiving any distribution on account of such Administrative Claim.
