

FIPUG's Motion for Extension of Time to File Intervenor Testimony


The Florida Industrial Power Users Group (FIPUG), pursuant to rule 28-106.204, files this request that the Commission enter an order granting an extension of time until Friday, October 12, 2001 for FIPUG to file its Intervenor testimony in this docket. As grounds therefor, FIPUG states:

1. FIPUG has been unable to complete the preparation of its Intervenor testimony in time for the October 10, 2001 filing deadline. FIPUG requests that the deadline to file its testimony in the docket be extended two days, until Friday, October 12, 2001.

2. Upon consultation, representatives for Tampa Electric, Florida Power and Light, Florida Power Corporation, Gulf Power, and Office of Public Counsel stated that they have no objections to the two-day extension of time sought by FIPUG. In addition, FIPUG contacted Public Service Commission Staff counsel who took no position as to this motion.

3. Given the brevity of the extension sought by FIPUG, no parties to the docket will experience any undue prejudice due to the brief two-day extension.

WHEREFORE, FIPUG requests that the Commission issue an order granting FIPUG's Motion for Extension of Time to File Intervenor Testimony until Friday, October 12, 2001.


