TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REBUTTAL TESTIMONY

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, moves the Commission for a two-day extension of time within which to file rebuttal testimony addressing the testimony to be submitted on behalf of the Florida Industrial Power Users Group ("FIPUG") and, as grounds therefor, says:

1. On October 9, 2001 FIPUG's counsel requested that Tampa Electric consent to a two-day extension of time for FIPUG to submit direct testimony in this proceeding. That extension of time would delay the filing from October 10 to October 12, 2001.

2. Tampa Electric advised FIPUG that it would not object to the two-day extension if FIPUG would agree to a two-day extension for Tampa Electric to submit any rebuttal testimony it may wish to file in response to FIPUG's direct testimony. FIPUG's counsel indicated that the mutual two-day extension was acceptable. Under this arrangement, Tampa Electric's rebuttal testimony would be due October 26 as opposed to the current due date of October 24, 2001. Office of Public Counsel was contacted and indicated that it had no problem with the requested two-day extension.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company respectfully requests an extension of time through and including October 26, 2001 within which to file rebuttal testimony addressing the direct testimony of FIPUG's witnesses in this proceeding.


