CITIZENS' PREHEARING STATEMENT

The Citizens of the State of Florida, through their attorney, the Public Counsel, consistent with Order No. PSC-01-1447-PCO-WS, hereby file this Prehearing Statement.

- (a) The Citizens will call Mark A. Cicchetti as an expert to testify on the proper leverage formula methodology to be used in establishing the authorized range of return on common equity for Commission regulated water and wastewater utilities. The Citizens will also call Mr. Cicchetti to rebut certain portions of the testimony submitted by Dr. Morin and Mr. Lester.
 - (b) Attached to Mr. Cicchetti's initial testimony are:
 - (1) Attachment I describing qualifications and experience;
 - (2) Attachment 2 Water Company Index Investment Characteristics (2 pages);
 - (3) Attachment 3 Discounted Cash Flow Model;
 - (4) Attachment 4 Risk Premium Analysis (4 pages);
 - (5) Attachment 5 Risk Premium Analysis Results; and
 - (6) Attachment 6 Summary of Results.
- (c) The leverage formula described in Order No. PSC-01-1226-PAA-WS results in liberal equity returns that equal or exceed the "range of returns on common equity for an average water and wastewater utility," as required by Section 367.081(4)(f), Florida Statutes.

(d) <u>ISSUE 1</u>: What is the appropriate range of returns on common equity for water and wastewater utilities pursuant to Section 367.081(4)(f), Florida Statutes?

POSITION: 9.14% ROE @ 100% equity ratio to 10.24% ROE @ 40% (or lower)

Equity ratio, based on the formula: Return on Common Equity = 8.41% + 0.731/Equity Ratio

(Cicchetti).

(e) <u>ISSUE 1</u>: Does Section 367.081(4)(f), Florida Statutes, allow the Commission to establish a leverage formula that systematically results in an allowed equity return that is higher than the actual measured cost of equity for an average water or wastewater utility at the corresponding equity ratio?

<u>POSITION</u>: No. Section 367.081(4)(f), F.S., contemplates the establishment of authorized equity returns that equal -- not systematically exceed -- the actual cost of equity.

(f) <u>ISSUE 1</u>: Should the Commission, as a matter of sound public policy, select a leverage formula that results in allowed equity returns that systematically exceed the actual measured cost of equity?

<u>POSITION</u>: No. Sound public policy would dictate that the leverage formula result in allowed equity returns that equal the actual measured cost of equity.

- (g) The Citizens are not aware of any issues that have been stipulated by the parties.
- (h) The Citizens are not aware of any pending motions.
- (i) The Citizens have no claims for confidentiality.

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(j) The Citizens believe they can comply with all requirements of Order No. PSC-01-1447-PCO-WS.
