Please be advised that we are the parent company of Centennial Florida Switch Corp. Pursuant to the telephone conversation between my assistant, Karen and Paula Isler of the Bureau of Service Quality, this will confirm that we wish to keep the Telecommunications Certificate active and that a check in the amount of \$67 representing the 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee, penalty and interest will be forwarded under separate cover.

Centennial Florida Switch Corp. is a new subsidiary of Centennial Communications, and unfortunately, we did not realize that there was a regulatory fee for the ALEC. We did not receive the Notice advising of the ALEC regulatory fee nor the late notice mailed on February 21st.

However, we would like to propose the following settlement of this matter:

1. In order to avoid future late payment of the regulatory assessment fee, we will calendar January 30th as the annual payment due date.
2. We agree to waive any objection to the administrative cancellation of our certificate should we fail to pay in accordance with our settlement offer. If, however, there is a factual dispute as to the manner or level of compliance with any provision in the settlement, Commission staff will bring the matter to the Commission for consideration.


