Please be advised that we are the parent company of Centennial Florida Switch Corp. Pursuant to the telephone conversation between my assistant, Karen and Paula Isler of the Bureau of Service Quality, this will confirm that we wish to keep the Telecommunications Certificate active and that a check in the amount of \$67 representing the 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee, penalty and interest will be forwarded under separate cover.

Centennial Florida Switch Corp. is a new subsidiary of Centennial Communications, and unfortunately, we did not realize that there was a regulatory fee for the ALEC. We did not receive the Notice advising of the ALEC regulatory fee nor the late notice mailed on February 21st.

However, we would like to propose the following settlement of this matter:

1.	In order to avoid future late payment of the regulatory assessment fee, we
will calendar	January 30 th as the annual payment due date.

2.	We agree to waive any o	objection to the administrative cancellation of our
certificate sho	ould we fail to pay in acco	rdance with our settlement offer. If, however,
there is a fact	ual dispute as to the mann	er or level of compliance with any provision in
the settlement	t, Commission staff will b	ring the matter to the Commission Wilsia

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3. As the failure to pay the regulatory fee was due to inadvertence, we respectfully propose the sum of \$150 in settlement of this matter.
