Re: Extension of Post-Termination Service in Florida

Dear Mr. Green:

In a letter dated September 5, 2001, Sprint agreed to provide MCImetro post-termination service for a ninety (90) day period ending November 19, 2001. In light of our dispute before the Florida Public Service Commission over the status of the Florida Interconnection Agreement, Sprint is willing to extend post-termination service as provided in the September 5th letter until December 21, 2001.

Sprint's position continues to be that the Florida Interconnection Agreement is no longer in effect. Subject to the Commission's resolution of the pending dispute, in order for MCImetro to order new services after December 21, 2001, MCImetro will need to have a valid interconnection agreement with Sprint. As noted in our August 21, 2001 and September 5th letters, Sprint is willing to explore different options with MCImetro, including entering into an interim arrangement or assisting MCImetro to opt-into an effective interconnection agreement in Florida.


