KMC Telecom, Inc. ("KMC"), by its attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification, and states the following:

1. On October 17, 2001, during the scheduled hearing in this docket, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. requested that KMC's witness James Sfakianos provide the "universe of appointments used to calculate the missed appointment percentages" asserted in his testimony. Accordingly, on October 29, 2001, KMC provided this information as late-filed Exhibit No. 42, along with a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification. KMC considers the number of customers it has, and the number of orders it submits during a particular period of time, to be confidential and proprietary information.


2. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.06(3)(a), KMC is now filing this Request for Specified Confidential Classification for the subject information because the information provided as late-filed Exhibit No. 42 contains company-specific business information that KMC considers proprietary and confidential. Pursuant to Section 364.183(3), Florida Statutes, this information is classified as "proprietary confidential business information." Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

3. KMC has treated, and intends to continue to treat the information for which specified confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, KMC moves the Florida Public Service Commission to enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential and proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.

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
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
