**RE:** Docket No. 011419-TL, BellSouth Petition for Expedited Review of Growth Code Denials  
by NANPA for the Brentwood Switch in the North Dade Exchange

On October 30, 2001, BellSouth filed a petition requesting the Commission overturn NANPA's decision to deny a growth code for the Brentwood switch in the North Dade rate center. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL (Docket No. 010782-TL) which approved an expedited process for code denials, we have examined the BellSouth petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a switch in a non-pooling multi-switch rate center which has a MTE of less than six months;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to customers from a switch in a multi-switch non-pooling rate center because its supply of numbers in less than six months; and
- 3) Customers will not be able to have a choice of providers because a provider will run out of numbers for that switch in a multi-switch non-pooling rate center within six months.

Since the three required criteria have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (November 21, 2001) as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. Three previous NANPA code denials orders have been issued using the new expedited process ( See Docket Nos. 011235-TL, 011266-TL, and 011312-TL).
