This letter is in response to the investigation of United States Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Tel Com Plus for violation of Section 364.183(1), F.S., access to company records. We had an outside source completing our compliance work. We took our records back in house around the same time your report was due. Unfortunately your report fell through the cracks during the process of setting up a new system of compliance. This was an oversight on our behalf.

We are addressing procedures to avoid similar events in the future. We sincerely regret not having an opportunity to respond and have our comments a part of your report to the Florida Legislature.

We understand that the commission is assessing penalties related to non-compliance. We wish to settle and are submitting an offer of \$3,500 to be paid \$500 over 7 months.
