IT IS INTENDED THAT THE BUYER WILL PURCHASE ANY AND ALL PHYSICAL IMPROVEMENTS RELATING TO THE WATER SYSTEM, TOGETHER WITH ANY AND ALL ACCOUNTS SERVICED BY THE WATER SYSTEM, WHETHER ACTUAL OR POTENTIAL, AND ANY AND ALL BOOKS, RECORDS, PERMITS, LICENSES OR OTHER MATTERS, TANGIBLE OR INTANGIBLE, WHICH IN ANY WAY RELATE TO, COMPRISE OR WHICH ARE A PART OF THE WATER SYSTEM.

THIS PURCHASE IS SUBJECT TO AND CONTINGENT UPON THE BUYER INSPECTING THE BOOKS AND RECORDS, CUSTOMER LISTS, ACCOUNTS, FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND OTHER FINANCIAL MATTERS RELATING TO THE WATER SYSTEM, THE SERVICE RECORDS OF THE WATER SYSTEM AND THE CONDITION OF THE WATER SYSTEM AND SAME BEING SATISFACTORY TO BUYER'S APPROVAL AT BUYER'S SOLE OPTION AND DISCRETION.
3. THAT SELLER AGREES THAT ANY AND ALL CUSTOMER DEPOSITS AND ANY INTEREST THEREON OWED TO ANY CUSTOMERS, AS WELL AS ANY PREPAID ACCOUNTS OR ANY OTHER FUNDS HELD BY SELLER FOR OR ON BEHALF OF ANY CUSTOMERS WILL BE RETURNED AND REMITTED TO THE INDIVIDUAL CUSTOMERS PRIOR TO THE CLOSING OF THIS TRANSACTION AND THE SELLER WILL INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS THE BUYER FROM ANY LOSS, DAMAGE OR LIABILITY WITH REGARD TO ANY DEPOSITS, PRE-PAID CHARGES OR OTHER FUNDS HELD BY SELLER FOR OR ON BEHALF OF ANY CUSTOMERS.

2. THE SELLER WARRANTS AND REPRESENTS THAT WITH REGARD TO *LINADALE WATER SYSTEM* THERE ARE NO GUARANTEED REVENUE CONTRACTS, NO DEVELOPER AGREEMENTS AND NO LEASES WHICH ARE APPLICABLE TO THE SYSTEM OR ANY OF ITS PROPERTY, TANGIBLE OR INTANGIBLE, ANY OF ITS REVENUE OR RECEIVABLES OR ANY OTHER ASSETS HELD BY, FOR OR ON BEHALF OF *LINADALE WATER SYSTEM* AND SELLER INDEMNIFIES AND HOLDS HARMLESS BUYER FROM ANY LOSS, DAMAGE OR LIABILITY WITH REGARD TO ANY SUCH GUARANTEED REVENUE CONTRACTS, DEVELOPER AGREEMENTS OR LEASES THAT WERE EFFECTIVE PRIOR TO CLOSING SHOULD THEY BE DISCOVERED TO EXIST SUBSEQUENT TO THE CLOSING OF THIS TRANSACTION.

3. SELLER HAS DISCLOSED TO THE BUYER THE DEBT OF THE UTILITY, WHICH DEBT CONSISTS SOLELY OF PAYMENT FOR LATE FILED ANNUAL REPORT AND ANY PENALTY DUE THEREON; REGULATORY ASSESSMENT; AQUAPURE OPERATOR NON-PAYMENT; AND NOTES PAYABLE BALANCES, ALL OF WHICH WILL BE PAID AT THE CLOSING OF THIS TRANSACTION OF *LINADALE WATER SYSTEM* AND ALL OF ITS ASSETS, TANGIBLE OR INTANGIBLE, WILL BE TRANSFERRED, AS OF THE DATE OF CLOSING, TO BUYER, FREE AND CLEAR OF ANY DEBTS, ENCUMBRANCES, CLAIMS OR LIABILITIES AND SELLER INDEMNIFIES AND HOLDS HARMLESS BUYER FROM ANY LOSS, DAMAGE OR LIABILITY WITH REGARD TO ANY OF SAME INCURRED PRIOR TO CLOSING, BUT DISCOVERED SUBSEQUENT TO THE CLOSING OF THIS TRANSACTION.
