3. FIPUG is a group of industrial customers who take service from Florida's investorowned utilities. Electricity represents one of FIPUG's members' largest variable costs. Therefore, FIPUG will be substantially affected by any action the Commission takes in this docket.

4. The affected agency is the Florida Public Service Commission, 2540 Shumard Oak

Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850.

5. In this docket, the Commission will review the investor-owned utilities' risk

management policies and procedures.

- 6. Disputed issued of material fact include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a. Has each investor-owned electric utility taken reasonable steps to manage the risks associated with its fuel transactions through the use of physical and financial hedging practices?
 - b. What is the appropriate regulatory treatment for gains and losses from hedging and investor-owned electric utility's fuel transactions through futures contracts?
 - c. What is the appropriate regulatory treatment for the premiums received and paid for hedging and investor-owned electric utility's fuel transactions through options contracts?
 - d. What is the appropriate regulatory treatment for the transaction costs associated with an investor-owned electric utility hedging its fuel transactions?
 - e. For the period March 1999 to March 2001, did FPL take reasonable steps to manage the risk associated with changes in natural gas prices?
 - f. What is the appropriate regulatory treatment for sales of natural gas and transportation capacity made by FPL to an unaffiliated company?
 - g. Has each investor-owned utility taken reasonable steps to manage the risks associated with wholesale power purchases?

- 7. Ultimate facts include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a. Whether the utilities are appropriately managing risk as it relates to fuel purchases;
 - b. Whether utilities are appropriately managing risk as it relates to wholesale power purchases.

WHEREFORE, FIPUG requests that the Commission grant its Petition to Intervene and that

it be accorded full party status in this docket.
