On January 31, 2001, Southern Company-Florida, LLC (Southern-Florida) with the agreement and consent of the other above named petitioners, filed a Request for Confidential Classification for information contained in Document No. 01442-01. This document, identified as the Need for Power Application Volume 1F - Confidential Exhibit B, contains certain specified information in the petitioner's Need for Power Application (NPA), including the Power Purchase Agreement.

Southern-Florida states that Document No. 01442-01 includes certain confidential pricing information, trade secrets and other sensitive contract terms and conditions negotiated by the parties. It is asserted that this information is proprietary, confidential business information, as defined in Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. Southern-Florida asserts that the disclosure of this information would harm the competitive business position of the company, particularly its ability to negotiate and enter into similar contracts on reasonable business terms.

Staff concurs with Southern-Florida's request to grant confidential status to Document No. 01442-01. However, in accord with Section 366.093(4), Florida Statutes, staff recommends that Document No. 01442-01 remain confidential for a period of eighteen months from the date of the request. Prior to the end of the eighteen month time period, it is anticipated that either Southern-Florida can renew its request for confidential status or the affected document can be returned to Southern-Florida.

On January 31, 2001, the Orlando Utilities Commission (OUC), filed a Request for Confidential Classification for information contained in Document No. 01440-01. This document is the petitioner's Volume 1E-Confidential Exhibit A to the Need for Power Application. This document contains the evaluations of the proposals OUC received in response to its Requests for Proposals (RFP) of generating alternatives.

OUC asserts that Document No. 01440-01 contains proprietary, confidential business information, as defined in Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. Bidders responding to OUC's RFPs consider their pricing proposals to be confidential and competitively sensitive. OUC assured these bidders that their responses would be treated as confidential. OUC asserts that disclosure of this information will impair its ability to engage in meaningful solicitations in the future.

Staff concurs with OUC's request to grant confidential status to Document No. 01440-01. However, in accord with Section 366.093(4), Florida Statutes, staff recommends that Document No. 01440-01 remain confidential for a period of eighteen months from the date of the request. Prior to the end of the eighteen month time period, it is anticipated that either OUC can renew its request for confidential status or the affected document can be returned to OUC.

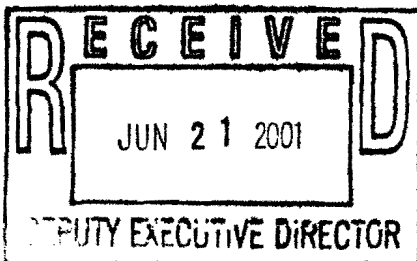

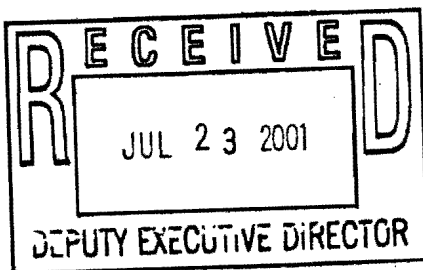

On January 31, 2001, Southern Company-Florida, LLC (Southern-Florida) with the agreement and consent of the other above named petitioners, filed a Request for Confidential Classification for information contained in Document No. **01442-01**. This document, identified as the Need for Power Application Volume 1F - Confidential Exhibit B, contains certain specified information in the petitioner's Need for Power Application (NPA), including the Power Purchase Agreement.

Southern-Florida states that Document No. 01442-01 includes certain confidential pricing information, trade secrets and other sensitive contract terms and conditions negotiated by the parties. It is asserted that this information is proprietary, confidential business information, as defined in Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. Southern-Florida asserts that the disclosure of this information would harm the competitive business position of the company, particularly its ability to negotiate and enter into similar contracts on reasonable business terms.

Staff concurs with Southern-Florida's request to grant confidential status to Document No. 01442-01. However, in accord with Section 366.093(4), Florida Statutes, staff recommends that Document No. 01442-01 remain confidential for a period of eighteen months from the date of the request. Prior to the end of the eighteen month time period, it is anticipated that either Southern-Florida can renew its request for confidential status or the affected document can be returned to Southern-Florida.


