I have reviewed our utility records to determine the effect of past and proposed changes in water costs at a typical residence. The following table summarizes those changes in cost.

Needless to say, I find it difficult to justify a 48% increase in water costs over a two year period either by increased operating costs or by a rational capital expenditure program.

I would hope that the Florida Public Service Commission carefully scrutinizes any justification provided by the Florida Public Utilities Company for the proposed rate increase including the disposition of revenues gained from last years 35.6% increase in costs.
