ALECs are encouraged to organize their presentations by OSS function (preordering, ordering, provisioning, maintenance and repairs) and to specifically identify each OSS involved.

All participants must file an outline of their presentation, the approximate amount of time for the presentation, and the presenter's name with the Commission's Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, FL 32399-0850, by February 8, 2002. In planning the presentations, participants are asked to be mindful that only one day is allotted for this workshop. As such, to the extent possible, participants are asked to coordinate regarding presentations to minimize redundancy. An agenda for this workshop will be available by February 13, 2002, and may be obtained by contacting the Division of Commission Clerk and Administrative Services.
