Dear Mr. Myers:

The Commission has received your 2001 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) return form, along with the minimum payment and with what appears to be a request for cancellation.

Normally, the effective date of a voluntary cancellation is the date the Commission received the company's request for cancellation as long as RAFs, including penalty and interest charges, are up-to-date. In this case, our records show that the 1999 RAF was paid after the due date, therefore, penalty and interest charges of \$16.50 are outstanding. Our records show that for the 1999 RAF, you paid \$0.62 RAF on January 26, 2000 and the balance of the minimum (\$49.38) on September 2, 2000, but that you did not pay the \$12.50 penalty and \$4.00 interest.

Once the \$16.50 is paid (postmarked by January 30, 2002), then the Commission will voluntarily cancel the certificate with an effective date of December 31, 2001.
