Verizon Florida Inc. (Verizon) requests the Florida Public Service Commission to direct the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) to provide Verizon with numbers in a number block for , and a block for .

The , a Verizon customer, has requested two new prefixes of sequential telephone numbers each to support their growing network which includes the opening of new schools, the addition of phone lines in each teacher's area, and to provide E911 capabilities to all telephones within the district. has informed Verizon that of these new numbers in each NXX will be used immediately and the remaining in each NXX will be placed in service in .

On or about August 7, 2001, Verizon submitted two Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Requests to NANPA for the assignment of NXX resources necessary to meet the request. A copy of these applications are attached as Attachments A and D. Verizon completed the applications in accordance with NANPA's Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines and completed the necessary Months to Exhaust Certifications, which are attached as Attachments B and E.

Verizon submitted the requests for new central office (NXX) codes because Verizon does not have sequential numbers available within the central office, and also does not have sequential numbers available within the central office to meet needs. Although the and offices are in the multi-switch rate centers of

and \_\_\_\_\_ respectively, Verizon is unable to use numbers from another switch within the rate centers to satisfy the request.

On or about August 17, 2001, NANPA's Central Office Code Administrator denied the requests on the grounds that Verizon had not met the rate center-based months-to-exhaust criteria set forth in the Central Office Code (NXX) Guidelines, notwithstanding the fact that Verizon does not have the numbering resources needed to satisfy its customer's demands in the switches at issue. These decisions are attached as Attachments C and F.

Under earlier months-to-exhaust procedures used by NANPA, waivers or exceptions were granted where customer hardships were demonstrated or where the service provider's inventory did not have a block of numbers large enough to meet a customer's specific request. Under existing procedures, NANPA looks at the number of months to exhaust for the entire rate center without any exceptions. However, the FCC's March 31, 2000 Order in its Number Resource Optimization docket states that a carrier may challenge a NANPA decision to the appropriate state regulatory commission and the state commission may choose to affirm or overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources (*Number Resource Optimization, Report and Order, CC Dkt. No. 99-200, FCC No. 00-104, at App. A, 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(iv).*) The Florida Commission thus has the authority to review NANPA decisions and reverse them when appropriate.

Verizon seeks the Commission's review of NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources. The CO Code Administration decision violates the intent and requirements of the FCC in allowing carriers access to numbering resources to meet specific customer demands upon a sufficient showing of need, and NANPA's denial of numbering resources interferes with Verizon's ability to serve its customers.

Verizon requests that the Commission instruct NANPA to release the numbering resources necessary to meet the needs of the
