

1. On January 31, 2002, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. filed a Petition for Expedited Review of Pooling Administrator's Denial of Request for Additional Numbering Resources along with Attachments 1, 2, and 3. On that same day, BellSouth also filed a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification for Attachment Nos. 1 and 3, which contain information that is considered confidential and proprietary to BellSouth.

3. BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.


4. Appended hereto as Attachment B are two copies of the requested documents with the confidential information deleted.


