Sun Communities Finance-Water Oak Utility

These comments are in response to the *Initial Customer Notice* I received as a resident of Water Oak Country Club community.

We understand Sun Communities has proposed a plan for reuse of waste water that will be used on the Water Oak Golf Course.

During a meeting of community residents I find most homeowners in the park feel an increase in water rates to build a water reuse system for the golf course should not be allowed by the Public Service Commission.

The golf course is <u>separately owned and is not part of the residential community</u>. We do not understand how the park residents can be charged for a system which benefits the golf course which is also open to the public.

Utility and capital expenditures are a part of the cost of doing business and Sun has over 100 residential parks.

- 1) We already pay a premium monthly fee to Sun Communities for living in this community in addition to water and sewer charges.
- 2) Even water that never goes through the sewer system when we are required to water lawns (owned by Sun) is charged an unfairly high sewer usage fee.
- 3) Real Estate taxes on vacant home lots owned by Sun are also charged to the residents which is not equitable.
- 4) What next??
