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FLORIDA POWER'S AMENDED FIFTH NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Florida Power Corporation ("Florida Power" or the "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Fla. Stats., and Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C., files this amended fifth notice of intent to request confidential classification for certain portions of the prefiled testimony of witness James A. Rothschild filed on January 18, 2002. Although confidential documents are referenced throughout Mr. Rothschild's testimony, the documents themselves are not attached as exhibits and therefore have not become public record. Florida Power reaffirms that nothing in this amended notice shall constitute a waiver of the confidentiality of any such document. Mr. Rothschild's testimony itself does not contain information warranting confidential classification.
