3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BOCA RATON  
4 STRONGLY RECOMMENDING THAT FLORIDA POWER  
5 AND LIGHT REOPEN THE PROCESS FOR  
6 CONSIDERATION AND RECONSIDERATION OF THE  
7 PROPOSED ROUTE OF THE PROPOSED NEW  
8 ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINE WITHIN THE CITY,  
9 CONSIDER ALTERNATIVE ROUTES OTHER THAN THE  
10 PROPOSED LOCATION, STUDY AND CONSIDER THE  
11 IMPACTS OF ANY AND ALL ROUTES ON ADJACENT  
12 RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITIES, AND SOLICIT AND  
13 CONSIDER INPUT FROM THE CITY AND ALL  
14 AFFECTED RESIDENTIAL HOMEOWNERS  
15 ASSOCIATIONS PRIOR TO MAKING A FINAL  
16 SELECTION OF A ROUTE FOR THE PROPOSED  
17 ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINE; PROVIDING FOR  
18 SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER;  
19 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

21 WHEREAS, Florida Power and Light ("FPL") has announced the proposed route of  
22 the proposed new electric transmission line (from Rainberry substation north of U.S. Route 441  
23 to Yamato Road, then east on Yamato Road to Jog Road, then north on Jog Road to the Clint  
24 Moore substation) which will be located, in part, within the City of Boca Raton (which portion of  
25 said route within the City is hereinafter referred to as "the Proposed Location"); and

1           WHEREAS, the Proposed Location is adjacent to numerous residential communities  
2 and at least three public schools which will be severely, adversely impacted by the proposed  
3 new electric transmission line; and

4           WHEREAS, there exist feasible, alternative routes for the proposed electric  
5 transmission line which may have less adverse impacts on existing developed areas; and

6           WHEREAS, FPL has not discussed the Proposed Location or the alternative routes  
7 with the City or the affected residential homeowners associations, or solicited input regarding  
8 the same from said entities; now therefore

10                           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOCA  
11 RATON:

13           Section 1. The City Council of the City of Boca Raton hereby strongly recommends  
14 that Florida Power and Light: (i) reopen the process for consideration and reconsideration of the  
15 proposed route of the proposed new electric transmission line; (ii) consider alternative routes  
16 (including undergrounding of transmission lines) other than the Proposed Location; (iii) study  
17 and consider the impacts of any and all routes on adjacent residential communities and at least  
18 three public schools; and (iv) solicit and consider input from the City and all affected residential  
19 homeowners associations prior to making a final selection of a route for the proposed electric  
20 transmission line.

21           Section 2. The City Council hereby directs the City Clerk to forward copies of this  
22 resolution to each of the members of the Public Service Commission and the Board of County  
23 Commissioners of Palm Beach County and to Florida Power and Light.

24           Section 3. If any section, subsection, clause or provision of this resolution is held  
25 invalid, the remainder shall not be affected by such invalidity.

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Section 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith shall be and hereby are repealed.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


