By letter dated November 19, 2001, Verizon Florida Inc. filed a Request for approval of 5th amendment to interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement entered into between Verizon Florida Inc. and Florida Digital Network, Inc. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was February 15, 2002.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on December 21, 2001. The agreement met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.17 of the Administrative Procedures Manual. Therefore, it has gone into effect by operation of law in accordance with Section 252(e)(4) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
