2 2000 conference call. BellSouth also points to the UNEs that were
3 ordered in March 2000 and in October 2000 as evidence that Supra
4 can and has ordered UNEs; these arguments are red herrings. To top
5 it all off, it is BellSouth's position that Supra is not entitled to order all
6 UNE combos; however, when Supra inquired as to the recurring and
7 nonrecurring charges for same on January 13, 2000 [Exhibit DN-38],
8 BellSouth's Mr. Finlen informed Supra, on April 17, 2000, that these
9 charges were in the Agreement, its attachments, and in its
10 amendments [Exhibit DN-39], which he correctly does, considering
11 that the FPSC had already ordered same in PSC-98-0810-FOF-TP.
12 **Exhibit DN-40.** BellSouth seeks to have it both ways – when Supra
13 requests additional pricing, BellSouth claims it already exists; but
14 when Supra requests the ability to order, BellSouth claims that Supra
15 needs more pricing.
