Order No. PSC-01-2257-PAA-TI, issued November 19, 2001, provides that if this Order is not protested and the fine is not received within five business days of the Consummating Order the fine shall be referred to the Comptroller's Office for further collection and that a protest in one Docket shall not prevent this Order from becoming final as it applies in another Docket.
