On May 29, 2001, Florida Power & Light Company, Florida Power Corporation, and Tampa Electric Company (collectively, the "Applicants") filed a Compliance Filing to the Commission's Order in <u>GridFlorida, LLC</u>, 94 FERC ¶ 61,363 (2001). Among other things, the Applicants explained that, shortly before their filing, the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC") initiated prudence investigations into their participation in GridFlorida. The Applicants committed to keep the Commission informed of the FPSC proceedings by filing copies of the FPSC's orders and further relevant pleadings.

On January 11, 2002, the FPSC filed with the Commission the FPSC's Order No. PSC-01-2489-FOF-EI ("Order"). The FPSC explained that it ordered the Applicants to file with the FPSC a proposal that conforms GridFlorida to the Order, including the adoption of an independent system operator structure instead of a transco structure. Attached is the filing made today by the Applicants with the FPSC in response to the Order. (As noted in the attached letter, certain documents will not be filed with the FPSC until March 21, 2002.) A copy of the Applicants' filing is being served on the parties of record to the underlying FPSC proceeding, and will be posted on the GridFlorida World Wide Web page, www.gridflorida.com.
