FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION FOR CERTAIN DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION FILED IN RESPONSE TO THE COMMISSION STAFF'S TENTH SET OF INTERROGATORIES

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code ("F.A.C."), Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby requests confidential classification of certain confidential information filed in response to the Commission Staff's Tenth Set of Interrogatories in connection with the Commission's Review of the Retail Rates of FPL and attached hereto as Attachment A ("the Confidential Information"). In support thereof, FPL states:

- 1. On February 12, 2002, the Commission Staff submitted to FPL its Tenth Set of Interrogatories in connection with the Review of Retail Rates of FPL. Information and documents responsive to Interrogatories 367, 372 and 382 in this discovery request constitute proprietary, confidential business information, the disclosure of which would injure FPL's customers and FPL's business operations.
- 2. On March 5, 2002, FPL filed with the Commission a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification ("Notice") pertaining to certain documents responsive to Staff's Tenth Set of Interrogatories to FPL, Nos. 367, 372 and 382 in Docket No. 001148-EI. Attached to the Notice was an envelope stamped "CONFIDENTIAL" that contained documents with the Confidential Information highlighted. Two redacted copies of the confidential documents were

attached to the Notice as well. Copies of the same documents in separate highlighted and redacted forms are attached to this Request.

- 3. The material for which confidential classification is sought is intended to be and has been treated by FPL as private and confidential and has not been publicly disclosed. All the information in Attachment A to this Request for which FPL seeks confidential classification is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (2001). The Commission has previously determined that the type of information for which FPL seeks confidential classification is proprietary confidential business information. The Confidential Information for which FPL seeks confidential classification will continue to be confidential for more than eighteen months; therefore, FPL seeks confidential classification for thirty-six months with the opportunity to request continuation of the confidential classification.
- 4. The material for which confidential classification is sought in response to Interrogatory 367 contains proprietary confidential business information regarding a settlement with the Internal Revenue Service and FPL's method of tax depreciation accounting. The Commission previously classified similar information as confidential in Order No. PSC-99-0462-CFO-EI, in agreement with FPL's position that disclosure of such information would enable FPL's competitors to obtain, at no cost to the competitors, the benefits of the utility's efforts concerning certain tax initiatives. Disclosure of the Confidential Information would injure FPL's customers and FPL's business operations.
- 5. The material for which confidential classification is sought in response to Interrogatory 372 contains proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes (2001). FPL requests confidential classification for a three-word portion of a contract for purchase of natural gas, the disclosure of which would impair the

efforts of FPL or its affiliates to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. See § 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes (2001). Disclosure of the Confidential Information would injure FPL's customers and FPL's business operations.

- 6. The material for which FPL seeks confidential classification in response to Interrogatory 382 is a portion of a two-page pricing model for natural gas marketing and is confidential proprietary business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes (2001). This Confidential Information is within the category of information concerning contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. See § 366.093(3)(d), Fla. Stat. (2001). This Confidential Information also is within the category of information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider. See § 366.093(3)(e), Fla. Stat. (2001).
- 7. To satisfy the requirements of Rule 25-17.006, Florida Administrative Code, FPL has prepared five Attachments to this Request. Attachment A, filed in an envelope marked "CONFIDENTIAL," is a copy of the pages of the responses that contain confidential information with all Confidential Information highlighted. Only the original copy of this request contains Attachment A; the remaining copies served upon the Commission and the parties do not contain a copy of Attachment A. Attachment B is a copy of the pages of the responses containing confidential information with the Confidential Information redacted. Attachment C is a line-by-line justification of the confidential status of the Confidential Information. Attachment D is the affidavit of Donald F. Chasmar explaining why the Confidential Information in response to Interrogatory 367 is proprietary and confidential and why it should not be publicly disclosed. Attachment E is the affidavit of C. Dennis Brandt explaining why the Confidential Information

in response to Interrogatories 372 and 382 is confidential and why it should not be publicly disclosed.

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests the Commission rule that the Confidential Information identified in Attachment A be given confidential classification and, thus, exempt it from public disclosure.






