RE: Docket No. 020236-TL, BellSouth Petition for Expedited Review of Growth Code Denial

by NANPA.

On March 13, 2002, BellSouth filed a petition requesting the Commission overturn NANPA's decision to deny a growth code in the Silver Oaks switch (MIAMFLSODS0), in the Miami rate center for 10,000 consecutive Direct Inward Dialing (DIDs) numbers. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL (Docket No. 010782-TL) which approved an expedited process for code denials, we have examined the BellSouth petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of immediate numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to the potential customer because of NANPA's denial of numbering resources; and
- The potential customer cannot obtain service from the provider of its choice because the carrier does not have numbers available to fulfill the customer's needs.

Since the three required criteria of Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (April 5, 2002) as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. Six previous NANPA code denials orders have been issued using the new expedited process (See Docket Nos. 011235-TL, 011266-TL, 011312-TL, 011419-TL, 011528-TL, and 020109 TL).
