

**PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF
ENVIRONMENTAL COST RECOVERY
TRUE-UP FOR THE PERIOD
JANUARY 2001 THROUGH DECEMBER 2001**

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby petitions this Commission for approval of FPL's final Environmental Cost Recovery Clause true-up amount of \$0 for the period January 2001 through December 2001 and an underrecovery of \$140,141 as the adjusted net true-up amount. This adjusted net true-up underrecovery of \$140,141 was recorded in a non-recoverable clause account, and it is not and will not be included for recovery through the Environmental Cost Recovery Clause. In support of this Petition, FPL states as follows:

1. The final Environmental Cost Recovery Clause true-up of \$0 for the period January 2001 - December 2001 was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Schedule A-2 for the Fuel Cost Recovery Clause, attached to Order 10093 dated June 19, 1981. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony of FPL witness K.M. Dubin, which is being filed together with the Petition and incorporated herein.
2. In Order No. PSC-01-2463-FOF-EI, the Commission approved an overrecovery, including interest, of \$140,141 as the estimated/actual environmental cost recovery true-up for the period January 2001 through December 2001.
3. The adjusted net true-up is an underrecovery of \$140,141, which is the difference between the actual true-up of \$0 and the estimated/actual true-up of \$140,141 overrecovery.


