1. On March 13, 2002, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. filed a Petition for Expedited Review of NXX-X Code Denials for the Daytona Beach Exchange (Daytona Beach Main and DeLand) along with Attachments 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5. On that same day, BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification for Attachment Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 because said attachments contained information that is considered confidential and proprietary to BellSouth.
2. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.06(3)(a), BellSouth is now filing a Request for Confidential Classification for Attachments 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 because said attachments contain competitive business information that is considered confidential and proprietary to BellSouth. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A.


