## SUPRA'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OF COMMISSION ORDER NO. PSC-02-0464-PCO-TP

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, Supra Telecommunications & Information Systems, Inc. ("Supra") submits this Motion for Reconsideration of Commission Order PSC-02-0464-PCO-TP, issued April 4, 2002. In support of its Motion, Supra states as follows:

- 1. Commission Order PSC-02-0464-PCO-TP, issued April 4, 2002, is **void** of any legal authority to substantiate the denial of Supra's Motion for Extension of Time.
- 2. The Commission Order simply refers to "The Courts have construed . . ."

  The Order does <u>not</u> identify which Courts or include any legal citation whatsoever.
- 3. The Commission cited City of Hollywood v. Public Employees Relations

  Commission, 432 So.2d 79 (Fla. 4<sup>th</sup> DCA 1983).
- 4. In City of Hollywood v. Public Employees Relations Commission, the
  Court held that in the absence of any authority within the APA
  (Administrative Procedures Act) the Public Employees Relations

- Commission lacked the "inherent power" to grant an extension of time on a motion for reconsideration.
- 5. The case of City of Hollywood v. Public Employees Relations Commission was decided in 1983. In 1997 14 years later the APA was amended to include express authority for the extension of time for all motions upon a showing of good cause. See Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code.
- 6. Given the language in City of Hollywood v. Public Employees Relations

  Commission, 432 So.2d 79 (Fla. 4<sup>th</sup> DCA 1983) which allows
  administrative agencies to grant an extension of time, if such authority is
  contained in the APA (which it now is), Supra cites to City of Hollywood

  v. Public Employees Relations Commission, as its authority in support of
  Supra's Motion.

WHEREFORE, Supra respectfully requests that the Commission reconsider its Order denying Supra's request for an extension of time, on the basis that the Order failed to cite any legal authority for its conclusion that the Commission did not have the power to grant such an extension. Accordingly, Supra respectfully requests that the Commission grant Supra's Request for an Extension of Time based upon the regulatory authority and case law cited in this Motion for Reconsideration. Supra also respectfully requests a decision on this motion no later than 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 9, 2002.
