On April 1, 2002, AT&T Communications filed a petition requesting the Commission overturn NANPA's decision to deny a growth code in the West Palm Beach Gardens switch (WPBHFLGRDS2), in the Fort Pierce rate center for 10,000 consecutive Direct Inward Dialing (DIDs) numbers. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL (Docket No. 010782-TL) which approved an expedited process for code denials, we have examined the AT&T Communications petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have concluded the following:

- 1) To fulfill a requirement of the expedited process, Staff contacted the proposed customer and was informed that the numbers were no longer needed.
- 2) Staff notified AT&T who stated they will issue a Petition to Withdraw the request for these numbers on April 16, 2002.
