Order No. PSC-01-2405-PAA-TI was issued on December 12, 2001. The company had until January 2, 2002 to protest. No protest was received, therefore, on January 4, the Consummating Order was issued, which canceled the company's certificate effective that date.

On February 1, 2002, Ms. Kay Flynn e-mailed staff and advised that the company's attorney, Mr. Jim Dickey, had called concerning the cancellation of World Access' ALEC certificate. In researching the matter, Ms. Flynn found that on August 7, 2001, the Commission received the company's 2000 RAF payment for its ALEC certificate. In addition to the RAF payment, a letter was attached dated August 3, 2001 proposing a \$100 settlement to resolve this docket, No. 010914-TI. The settlement proposal was inadvertently not provided to technical staff nor documented in the docket file.

After several conversations with Mr. Dickey and among staff, and because on April 9, 2002, the company paid the 2000 RAF, plus all past due penalty and interest, we believe that this docket should be reopened so that staff can take a recommendation to the Commissioners to vacate the Order cancelling the certificate and accept the company's settlement proposal, thereby keeping the certificate active.

Accordingly, please reopen this docket. I will revise the CASR once the docket has been reopened. Let me know if you have any questions.
