SPRINT'S POST-HEARING STATEMENT

Pursuant to Order No. PSC-02-0313-PHO-TL, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated, Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership, and Sprint PCS (hereinafter "Sprint") submit the following Post-hearing Statement:

INTRODUCTION

This docket was initiated for the purpose of addressing area code relief for the 407/321 area code. Initially, six issues were included in the procedural order governing the conduct of the proceedings. The Commission held a technical hearing on March 14, 2002. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Commission issued a bench decision resulting in a final order on Issues 1-3 (Order No.PSC-02-0405-FOF-TL).

Two substantive issues¹ remain to be addressed by the Parties in their post-hearing statements. These issues involve the appropriate code assignment in a portion of Volusia County (the Osteen issue). Sprint initially took the position that this issue was not appropriately addressed in the area code relief docket. However, to the extent that the Commission will consider and address these issues in a subsequent order issued in this docket, Sprint has changed

its prehearing position to adopt BellSouth's positions and discussion of these issues, as reflected in BellSouth's post-hearing brief.

ISSUES AND POSITIONS

ISSUE 4: What type of mechanisms, not previously considered, if any, should the Commission approve to address Volusia County's area code and local dialing issues, and, if so, when?

Position: Sprint adopts the position, discussion and arguments on Issue 4 set forth in BellSouth's post-hearing brief.

ISSUE 5: Pursuant to the Florida Statutes, FCC delegated authority, or both, does the Commission have the authority to require telecommunications carriers to place 386 numbers in their Sanford exchange to allow customers in the Osteen area to get new lines and migrate their existing services the 386 numbers?

Position: Sprint adopts the position, discussion and arguments on Issue 5 set forth in BellSouth's post-hearing brief
