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ALLIED/CFI'S JOINDER IN SUPPORT OF TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR RETURN OF CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENTS OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE CONFIDENTIAL PROTECTION AFFORDED SUCH DOCUMENTS BY THE COMMISSION

Allied Universal Corporation and Chemical Formulators, Inc. Pursuant to Section 366.093(2), Florida Statutes, and Order No. PSC-01-0401-PHO-EI issued February 16, 2001, Allied supports TECO's request that any documents and information which have determined to be confidential but have not been entered into the record of the proceeding be returned to the respective provider of the information.
- 4. Alternatively, and consistent with TECO's request, Allied/CFI requests that all of the documents granted confidential treatment that are not part of the record in this proceeding, if not returned to the provider of the documents, continue to be treated as confidential.
