Dear Mr. Dodge:

I've received your April 5<sup>th</sup> letter concerning the request for cancellation of Exario's ALEC certificate. In your letter, you stated that since the company did not have any revenues, it was "exempt from paying the regulatory assessment fee." Unfortunately, that is not the case. The regulatory assessment fee (RAF) is due if a certificate is active for any period during a calendar year. In the case of Exario, even if the company had notified the Commission the same year its certificate became active (2001) that it had no revenues and requested cancellation of its certificate, it would still owe the minimum \$50.00 RAF. Unfortunately, we were not notified until 2002, which means the company owes the 2002 RAF in addition to the 2001 RAF.

Attached is a copy of the Commission Order issued on December 5, 2001, granting the company's ALEC certificate. The first paragraph on page 3 notifies the company that a minimum RAF is due. In addition, each applicant must sign an affidavit that it has read and understood Commission rules before certificates are granted.

The entities listed below have applied for certificates to provide Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications (ALEC) service, pursuant to Section 364.337, Florida Statutes. Upon review of their applications, it appears that these entities have sufficient technical, financial, and managerial capability to provide such service. Accordingly, we hereby grant to each of these entities the certificates depicted below, which shall authorize them individually to provide ALEC services throughout the State of Florida.

If this Order becomes final and effective, it will serve as each entity's certificate. Each entity should, therefore, retain this Order as proof of certification. We are vested with jurisdiction on this matter pursuant to Sections 364.335 and 364.337, Florida Statutes.

ALEC providers are subject to Chapter 25-24, Florida Administrative Code, Part XV, Rules Governing Telecommunications Service Provided by Alternative Local Exchange Companies. ALEC providers are also required to comply with all applicable provisions of Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 25-4, Florida Administrative Code.

Pursuant to Section 364.337(2), Florida Statutes, basic telecommunications service provided by an ALEC "... must include access to operator services, "911" services, and relay services for the hearing impaired." Further, Section 364.337(2), requires that an ALEC's "911" service "... shall be provided at a level equivalent to that provided by the local exchange telecommunications company serving the same area."

In addition, under Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, certificate holders must pay a minimum annual Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAFs) of \$50 if the certificate was active during any portion of the calendar year. A RAFs Return notice will be mailed each December to each of the entities listed above for payment in January. Neither the cancellation of its certificate nor the failure to receive a RAFs Return notice shall relieve any of these entities from its obligation to pay RAFs.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that we hereby grant, to the entities listed herein, certificates to provide Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications services, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that this Order shall serve as each entity's certificate and should, therefore, be retained by these entities as proof of certification. It is further

ORDERED that any protest to the action proposed herein shall specify the entity or entities to which it applies. It is further

ORDERED that, if a protest is filed as to the certification of any particular entity or entities, that protest shall not prevent the action proposed herein from becoming final with regard to the remaining entities listed in this Order. It is further





On March 29, 2002, the Commission received your letter dated March 22<sup>nd</sup> requesting cancellation of Exario's ALEC Certificate No. 7991. In order to grant a voluntary cancellation, a telecommunications company must be up-to-date on its Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAF) and comply with Rule 25-24.820, Florida Administrative Code, copy enclosed.

I have also enclosed copies of the 2001 and 2002 RAF returns. The 2001 RAF was due January 30, 2002. Since it is after the due date, statutory penalty and interest charges are applicable. In addition, Exario either needs to pay the 2002 RAF or provide a date certain the current year's RAF will be paid. There is a minimum annual \$50 RAF whether or not a company had any revenues.

## **25-24.820 Revocation of a Certificate.**

(1) The Commission may on its own motion, after notice and opportunity for hearing, revoke a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:

- (a) Violation of a term or condition under which the authority was originally granted;
- (b) Violation of Commission rule or order;
- (c) Violation of Florida Statute; or
- (d) Violation of a price list standard.

(2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request. Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the required information.

- (a) A statement of intent and date certain to pay regulatory assessment fee.
- (b) A statement of why the certificate is proposed to be canceled.
- (c) A statement as to how customer deposits and final bills will be handled.
- (d) Proof of individual customer notice regarding discontinuance of service.


