Dear Mr. Thompson:

Today, the Commission received the 2001 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) return forms for both your interexchange carrier and shared tenant service certificates, along with the \$50 minimum RAF for each certificate.

As background, in January, the Commission received the company's 2001 RAF return form on your shared tenant service certificate with a note advising the company is out of business. The minimum RAF was not included. In researching Travelers Media, Inc., I found that it also had an interexchange carrier certificate. I wrote you on January 16, 2002 and explained that if the 2001 RAFs were paid by the due date of January 30, 2002, the effective date of the cancellations would be December 31, 2001. Unfortunately, we did not receive payment until March 28, 2002, and the statutory penalty and interest charges were not paid.

To avoid any misunderstanding and if Travelers Media, Inc wishes to voluntarily cancel its interexchange carrier and shared tenant service certificates, it must pay the statutory penalty (\$5/each certificate) and interest (\$1/each certificate) charges for late payment of the 2001 RAF (a total of \$12). In addition, the company must either pay the 2002 RAF for each certificate (\$100 total) or provide a date certain the 2002 fees will be paid. The 2002 RAF forms are enclosed.

The alternative is for the Commission to cancel your two certificates on its own motion for violation of the RAF rule. If your certificates are cancelled on the Commission's own motion, any unpaid RAFs will be turned over to collections.

Please review this information and let me know by April 12, 2002 how you wish to proceed.
