As a follow-up to our recent telephone conversation, it is my understanding that you have confirmed with the Department of Community Affairs ("DCA") that the development approval for the territory requested by the application submitted in this docket has been delayed once again. Because DCA has indicated that it will be November at the earliest before the development will be able to obtain the necessary approvals, it would appear advisable to revise the schedule in this docket. The current CASR provides for a staff recommendation in late June. I would suggest that this date should be changed until some time subsequent to the anticipated decision on the regulatory approvals for this development.
