RE: Docket No. 010153-WU - Petition by Citizens of the State of Florida to open investigation into quality of service provided by Florida Water Services Corporation to Deltona service territory.

ISSUE 1: Should OPC's Notice of Withdrawal of its Petition to open an investigation into the quality of service provided to FWSC's Deltona service area be acknowledged?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes, OPC's Notice of Withdrawal should be acknowledged. The contamination appears to have been very limited in scope, and there has been no recurrence since remedial action and testing have been performed by the utility. Further, Commission staff, the Department of Environmental Protection and the Volusia County Health Department will continue to monitor the matter as necessary. FWSC should be required to notify staff should a complaint of larval contamination be brought to FWSC subsequent to this recommendation.
