ISSUE 1: Should the Commission approve the energy charge treatment contained in Paragraph 6b of the Contract of Tampa Electric Company and IMC to Facilitate Optional Provision Purchases of Electric Power?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes.

MODIFIED

Paragraphs 6a and 6b were approved based on IMC's assurance that if a cross-subsidy is found, the ratepayers will be made whole. TECO will make an after-the-fact filing demonstrating no harm to the ratepayers. Additionally relief is applied prospectively from the day of this vote.
