By letter dated February 19, 2002, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated filed a request for approval of adoption of the CMRS interconnection agreement entered into between Sprint-Florida, Incorporated and Nextel South Corp. which was deemed approved by the Commission on January 27, 2002. (See Docket No. 011339-TP) NPCR, Inc. d/b/a Nextel Partners is adopting the CMRS interconnection agreement approved by the Commission in its entirety pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. §252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(i) requires that a local exchange carrier shall make available any interconnection, service, or network element provided under an agreement approved by the state commission to any other requesting telecommunications carrier upon the same terms and conditions as those provided in the agreement in its entirety.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on May 22, 2002. The filing met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.15 of the Administrative Procedures Manual in that it complies with Section 252(i) of the Act. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
