This letter is to inform you of the status of the discussions between AT&T and BellSouth regarding AT&T's complaint against BellSouth for blocking calls to Oddball Codes and for BellSouth's refusal to port telephone numbers assigned from Oddball Codes.

Technical personnel from both AT&T and BellSouth have met and conducted a number of tests. As a result of those meetings, additional tests have been conducted by AT&T. At this time there are still certain calls to 954-930 numbers that still do not complete. AT&T is still working on this problem and will consult with BellSouth regarding these problems. We do not have an estimate of the time to resolve these problems but do not anticipate that the resolution will take a great deal more time. Notwithstanding, it appears that the problems that are the basis of the AT&T complaint are "solvable" and will be solved.
