#### CASE BACKGROUND

On December 5, 2001, Peoples Gas System petitioned for a determination that the rate structure of Withlacoochee River Electric Cooperative (WREC) is unduly discriminatory, interferes with Peoples' conservation programs, and is contrary to the legislative intent of the Florida Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act (FEECA).

Peoples is a public utility that owns and operates a natural gas distribution system throughout most of Florida. WREC owns and operates an electric distribution system, and provides retail
