The Commission should cancel the company's IXC Certificate No. 6034 and ALEC Certificate No. 5588 on its own motion, effective August 8, 2001. The collection of the past due fees should be referred to the Office of the Comptroller for further collection efforts. If the certificates are cancelled in accordance with the Commission's Order from this recommendation, the company should be required to immediately cease and desist providing IXC and ALEC services in Florida.
