ISSUE 1: Should the Commission approve the proposed settlement?
RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should approve the proposed settlement. The utility should file revised tariff sheets which are consistent with the Commission's vote. Staff should be given administrative authority to approve the revised tariff sheets upon staff's verification that revised tariff sheets are consistent with the Commission's decision. If revised tariff sheets are filed and approved, the charges should become effective for connections made on or after the stamped approval date of the revised tariff sheets, pursuant to Rule 25-30.475, Florida Administrative Code.
