By letter dated March 26, 2002, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated filed a request for approval of adoption of interconnection and resale agreement with Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P. by The Ultimate Connection, L.C. d/b/a DayStar Communications which was deemed approved by the Commission on June 5, 2001. (See Docket No. 010344-TP) The Ultimate Connection, L.C. d/b/a DayStar Communications is adopting the CMRS interconnection agreement approved by the Commission in its entirety pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(i) requires that a local exchange carrier shall make available any interconnection, service, or network element provided under an agreement approved by the state commission to any other requesting telecommunications carrier upon the same terms and conditions as those provided in the agreement in its entirety.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on June 21, 2002. The filing met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.15 of the Administrative Procedures Manual in that it complies with Section 252(i) of the Act. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
