

2. Gulf Power Company ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or "the Company"], by and
through its undersigned attorney's and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code,
hereby gives notice that it intends to request confidential classification for portions of Gulf Power's
responses to Staff's First Request for Production of Documents to Gulf Power Company (Nos. 1-10)
and Staff's First Set of Interrogatories (1-23). A copy of the requests is attached hereto as exhibit "A".

3. Gulf Power Company's response to request for production of documents
number 1 at subpart A, D, E and F and response to interrogatory number 10 contain proprietary and
commercially sensitive information which, if disclosed publically, would cause irreparable harm to the
business interests of Gulf Power Company and the ability of Gulf to obtain goods and services at

competitive prices on behalf of its customers. Subpart C of the request for production of documents number 1 is already public knowledge and is not confidential. Subpart B of the request for production of documents number 1 is already the subject of a pending request for confidential classification filed on June 11, 2002, which is identified as document number 06066-02 in the Commission's records. Gulf asserts that the information being provided in response to request for production of documents number 1 at subpart A, D, E and F and the response to interrogatory number 10 meets the requirements of §366.093(3)(a), (d) and (e), Florida Statutes. A formal request for confidential classification will be filed within the time period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, if the Staff determines that the information will be retained by the Commission and not returned to Gulf Power Company within the specified time period. In the event the Staff determines that it will retain this information, Gulf Power Company requests to be notified, through the undersigned counsel, prior to the expiration of the period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a).

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
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
