


COMMENTS OF WORLDCOM, INC.

MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, and MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. (collectively "WorldCom") believe the metrics and benchmarks proposed by Sprint in this docket are inadequate. Although WorldCom does not plan to participate to the fullest extent in this docket, WorldCom is dismayed by many of the benchmarks proposed by Sprint.

After careful and extensive review, the Commission has established performance measures and remedies for BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. in Docket No. 000121-TP. The BellSouth Plan is quite thorough and would be a strong model for the Commission to use in its review of Sprint's plan. At a minimum, Sprint should at least be required to ramp up from the Nevada flow-through levels to that the Commission has established for the BellSouth plan. Further, WorldCom does not want to foreclose the opportunity to revisit the metrics, benchmarks and remedies as its market activities in Sprint's territory increase.

WorldCom respectfully urges the Commission to adopt the Nevada measures and remedy plan to cover the metrics Sprint proposes in this proceeding and to have periodic reviews of the plan after it has been established.


