## MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE DIRECT TESTIMONY AND EXHIBITS OUT OF TIME

MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc ("WorldCom"), and MCImetro Access

Transmission Services, LLC ("MCImetro Access") hereby move to file direct testimony and exhibits in this proceeding one day after the filing date set forth in the Order Establishing

Procedure No PSC-02-0853-PCO-TP. In support, WorldCom and MCImetro Access state:

- 1. Under the Order Establishing Procedure, direct testimony and exhibits were to be filed by 5:00 p.m. on July 1, 2002. WorldCom and MCImetro Access intended to file direct testimony and exhibits along with a Petition to Intervene by such time. However, due to computer problems at undersigned counsel's office, there was a delay in final preparation of the documents. As a result, the documents were delivered to the Commission minutes after the Clerk's office closed at 5:00 p.m.
- 2. WorldCom and McImetro Access are filing this motion, along with the Petition to Intervene and direct testimony and exhibits, as the Clerk's Office opens on July 2, 2002.

  Moreover, WorldCom and McImetro timely served all parties copies of the direct testimony and exhibits on July 1, 2002. Accordingly, no parties are prejudiced by the short filing delay.



- 3. In this docket, the Commission will address BellSouth's proposal to establish a new tariff that would apply to intrastate access related to SS7 service. The effect of this Proposed Tariff may be that every ILEC, ALEC, IXC and wireless carrier will raise rates to recover this new charge from either other carriers or from the consumer and will also restructure their access tariffs to charge BellSouth the SS7 message costs that each of these carriers also incur to complete calls.
- 4. WorldCom and McImetro Access are certified by the Commission as alternative local exchange telecommunications company ("ALECs"). Also, WorldCom is certified by the Commission on interexchange telecommunications company ("IXC"). Both WorldCom and McImetro Access may be subject to the SS7 message charges reflected in the Proposed Tariff. Accordingly, the substantial rights and interests of both WorldCom and McImetro Access are affected by the Proposed Tariff and the decisions made by the Commission concerning the Proposed Tariff in this proceeding. WorldCom and McImetro Access respectfully submit that their direct testimony and exhibits will assist the Commission in its consideration of this matter
- 5. In accordance with Rule 28-106.204(3), Fla. Admin. Code, undersigned counsel has attempted to confer with all parties regarding their position on this motion. Counsel for the Commission, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., and Time Warner Telecom of Florida, LP, all indicated that they do not object to this motion. Undersigned counsel was not able to reach USLEC of Florida, Inc., or ITC^DeltaCom Communication to determine their position on this motion.

WHEREFORE, MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc ("WorldCom")., and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC ("MCImetro Access") hereby move to file direct testimony

and exhibits in this proceeding one day after the filing date set forth in the Order Establishing

Procedure No PSC-02-0853-PCO-TP.
